Take Home Tasks

Below are a selection of optional tasks and projects which you can complete at home or with your family that relate to our focus on the Ancient Greeks this half term. We will celebrate any challenges you complete in our Year 5 assembly, and display them in an area of the academy. You can bring them in at any time during this half term. **Who can get the most?**

- a) Research a Greek myth. Create a storyboard or cartoon of your chosen myth remembering to include all the key points.
- b) Alternatively, create a newspaper article reporting on a Greek myth.
- c) Design a vase that might have been used in Ancient Greece. You can use images of real vases to inspire ideas.
- d) Find out about life in an Ancient Greek household and write a diary from the perspective of a child living in this time period.
- e) Create a fact file based on one of the Ancient Greek gods.
- f) Use an atlas and draw the country of Greece freehand. Label the capital city and seas around it.

- g) Make a Greek theatre mask depicting a particular expression.
- h) Design your own Episemon (sign) that you might use on a shield or banner.
- i) Make your own name plaque using Greek letters.
- j) Design, create or write about your own mythical creature. Go wild!
- k) Create a poster sharing the works of one of Ancient Greece's famous inventors.
- l) Create a 3D model of the Parthenon in Athens.
- m) Write a travel brochure about Ancient Greece and include recommendations on places to visit. Try to include real facts and illustrate your travel guide.

Every Friday, you will continue to receive the following homework:

- One 40 minute piece of maths homework, set by your maths teacher.
- A set of spellings to learn. These spellings need to be practised in your **Spelling Journal**, for at least **30 minutes a week**.

Homework is **due** the following **Thursday morning**.

You need to read at least 5 times a week.

This **must** be recorded and signed by an adult in your reading journal.

These will be checked **every week** by your class teacher or LSA.
