Mythical creature related activities

- Make your own mythical creature using papier mâché.
- Create your own mythical creature word search.
- Create your own mythical creature hunt in your house or garden (draw pictures of your favourite mythical creatures and hide them for your family to find).
- Write your own story or poem about your favourite mythical creature.
- Write a diary entry as if you are a famous mythical creature hunter.
- Research Anglo-Saxon mythical creatures and write a fact file about them.



Anglo Saxon related activities

- Use the internet to find out as many Anglo-Saxon names as you can. Does your family have an Anglo-Saxon name?
- Plan and create your own Anglo-Saxon settlement or village.
- Practise writing out the Anglo-Saxon alphabet with its 28 runes or characters. Can you write your name in runes?
- Design an Anglo-Saxon brooch.
- Use card and wool to practise hand weaving.
